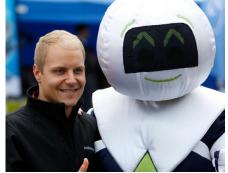

- Long tradition in advocating safe mobility for all



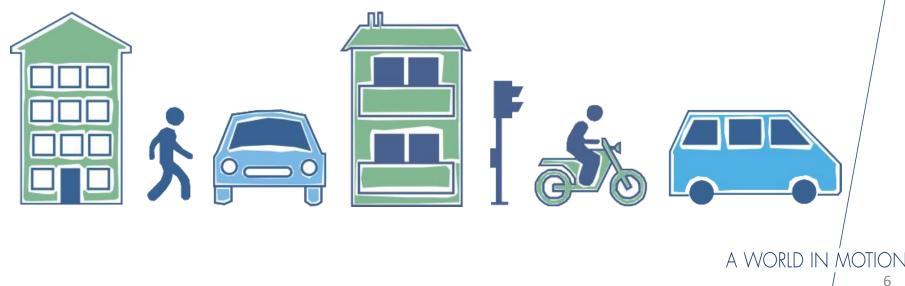
