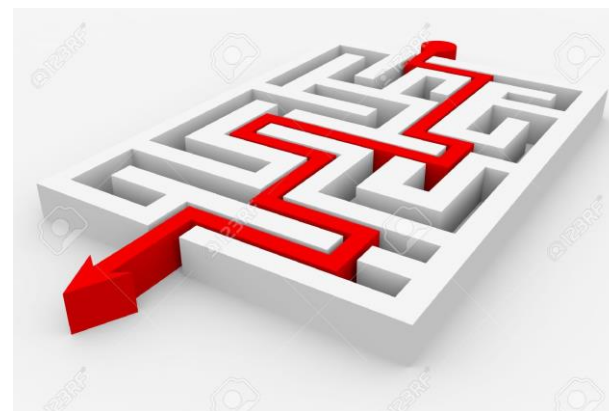
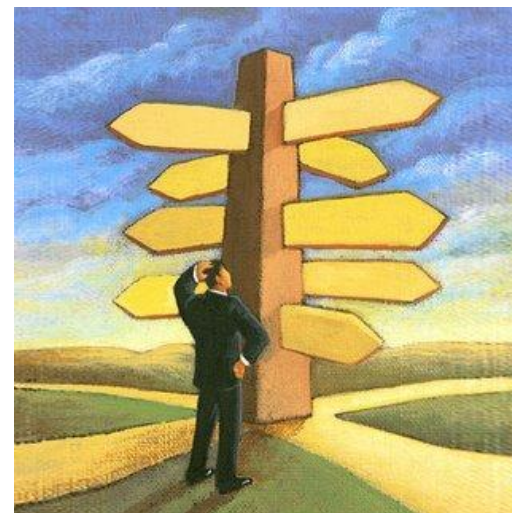
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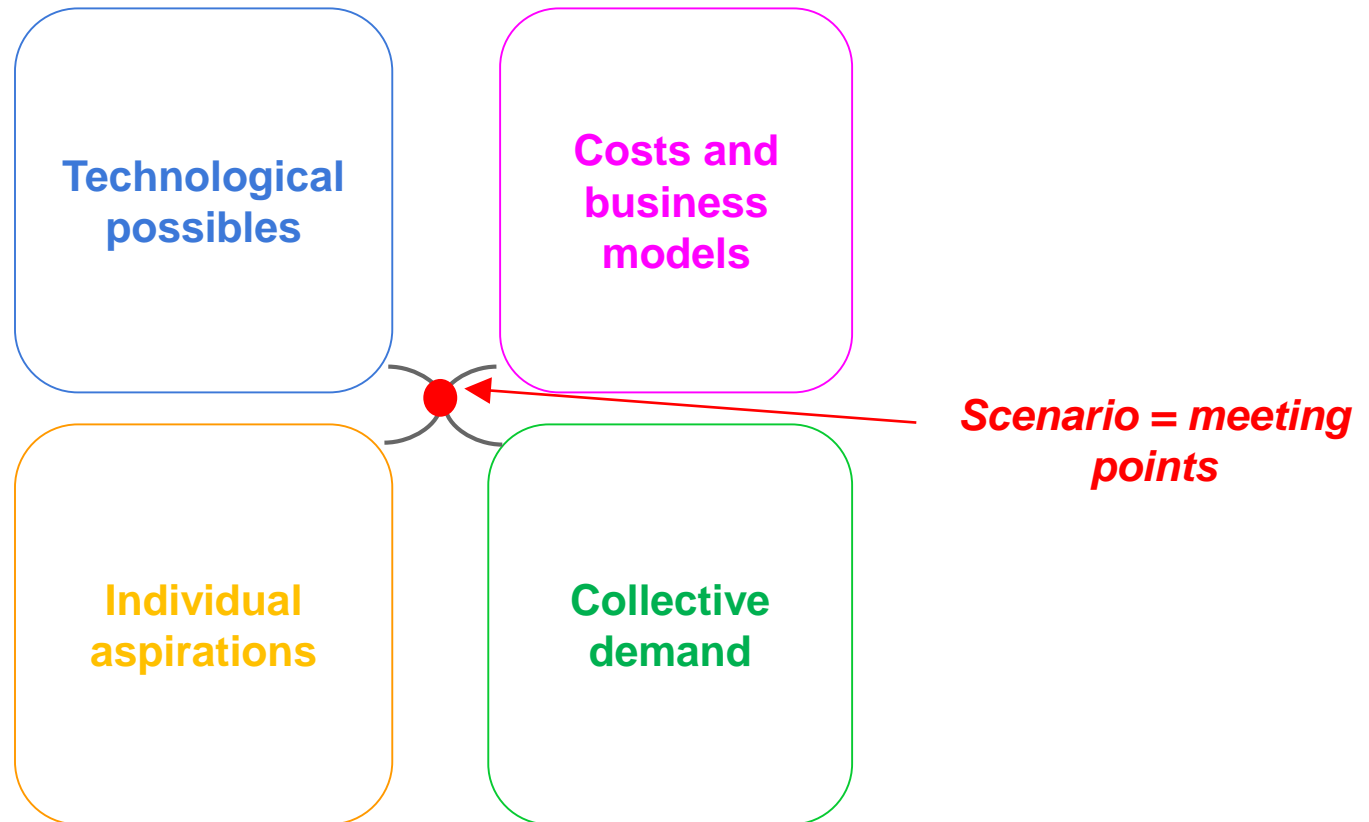

Why to think about the future of autonomous mobility?

- **Great uncertainty** about its development pathways
 - Enthusiasm for an **(immature)** technology
 - Few reflections about the **transition period**
 - **Different visions** of a autonomous-mobility based system
- Potential pathways will have **different impacts regarding sustainable mobility**
- An assumption : there are scopes for **political actions to drive the future** toward more sustainable options

What could autonomy learn from collaborative mobility?

- Actors of collaborative mobility bring a knowledge of car-based mobility that will be useful for autonomous mobility
- Sharing is not “natural”
- Public authorities are not easy to circumvent



What can be expected for the collaborative mobility sector?

- On the short-term, new opportunities
 - To scale-up the business : autonomy functions make it easy to share cars
 - To diversify activities, as collaborative mobility actors have valuable data and skills for autonomous mobility
- On the long-term, the end of collaborative mobility?
 - The rise of autonomous-mobility based services would mean the end of privately-owned cars and so of P2P collaborative mobility
 - Different collaborative mobility services could merge (no more difference between e-hailing and carsharing)
 - New frontier for sharing in transport ?
